

SUPPLEMENTARY LEADERSHIP SELECTION RULES

In accordance with clauses 64(c) and (d) and Rule 340 of the *Leadership Selection Rules*, the Leadership Selection Committee hereby prescribes the following rules:

1. These rules may be cited as the *Supplementary Leadership Selection Rules*.

PARTY LOGO AND SYMBOLS

2. For the purposes of Rule 337 of the *Leadership Selection Rules*, "leadership candidate" shall include a prospective candidate.

INITIAL MEMBERSHIP LIST

3. Leadership candidates, upon being accredited as a leadership candidate, shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party with an electronic list of the names of persons who are members of the Party, or who had been a member in 2006 or a subsequent year, and shall include in respect of each of those persons,
 - (a) an address;
 - (b) a telephone number, where available;
 - (c) an e-mail address, where available;
 - (d) the date of the last current membership; and
 - (e) the constituency association where the person is, or was most recently, a member.
4. The list provided in accordance with Rule 3 shall be current as of 31 May 2010.

LIST – LONG SERVING SUPPORTERS

5. Leadership candidates, upon being accredited as a leadership candidate, shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party with an electronic list of the names of persons submitted by Constituencies on or before March 31, 2010 as 'long serving supporters' and shall include in respect of each of those persons,
 - (a) an address;
 - (b) a telephone number, where available;
 - (c) an e-mail address, where available;
 - (d) the date of the last current membership; and

- (e) the constituency association where the person is, or was most recently, a member.

INTERIM MEMBERSHIP LIST

- 6. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party, upon the later of 8 July 2010 or being accredited as a leadership candidate, with an electronic list of the members of the Party as of 1 July 2010, and shall include in respect of each of those members, the member's
 - (a) name;
 - (b) address;
 - (c) telephone number, where available;
 - (d) e-mail address, where available; and
 - (e) constituency.

FINAL MEMBERSHIP LIST

- 7. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party on 27 September 2010 with an electronic list of the members of the Party as of 14 September 2010, and shall include in respect of each of those members, the member's
 - (a) name;
 - (b) address;
 - (c) telephone number, where available;
 - (d) e-mail address, where available; and
 - (e) constituency.

CONFIDENTIALITY OF LISTS

- 8. No list of members of the Party, delegates or alternate delegates, provided to a leadership candidate in accordance with the *Leadership Selection Rules* or these rules shall be used by a leadership candidate, a leadership candidate's campaign, or any supporter of a leadership candidate, for a purpose other than the leadership selection process.

RELEASE OF LISTS OF DELEGATES AND ALTERNATE DELEGATES

9. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party on 12 October 2010 with lists of delegates and alternate delegates, which shall include with respect to each of the individuals listed, the
 - (a) individual's name;
 - (b) individual's address;
 - (c) individual's telephone number, where available;
 - (d) individual's e-mail address, where available;
 - (e) individual's constituency association of record;
 - (f) individual's status as a delegate or an alternate delegate, as the case may be;
 - (g) individual's ranking as an alternate delegate, if the individual is an alternate delegate; and
 - (h) constituency association or qualifying association by which the individual was selected as a delegate or alternate delegate, or if the individual is an ex officio delegate, as the case may be.
10. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party on 18 October 2010 with lists of delegates and alternate delegates, which shall include with respect to each individual listed, the categories of information set out in Rule 9.
11. If there have been any changes since 18 October, 2010, leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party on 21 October 2010 with lists of delegates and alternate delegates, which shall include with respect to each individual listed, the categories of information set out in Rule 9.
12. For greater certainty, the lists to be provided in accordance with Rules 10 and 11 are intended to be interim lists containing entries based on the results transmitted in accordance with Rules 188 and 189 of the *Leadership Selection Rules* which have been processed at the Provincial Director of the Party for the purposes of preparations for the Convention prior to the respective dates of the release of the lists.
13. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party on 25 October 2010 with lists of delegates and alternate delegates, which shall include with respect to each of the individuals listed,
 - (a) the individual's name;
 - (b) the individual's address;

- (c) the individual's telephone number, where available;
- (d) the individual's e-mail address, where available;
- (e) the individual's constituency association of record;
- (f) the individual's status as a delegate or an alternate delegate, as the case may be;
- (g) the individual's ranking as an alternate delegate, if the individual is an alternate delegate; and
- (h) the constituency association or qualifying association by which the individual was selected as a delegate or alternate delegate, or if the individual is an ex officio delegate, as the case may be; and
- (i) whether the individual has paid the prescribed registration fees.

14. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party as soon as practical after the close of registration on 29 October 2010 with lists of delegates and alternate delegates, which shall include with respect to each of the individuals listed,

- (a) the individual's name;
- (b) the individual's address;
- (c) the individual's telephone number, where available;
- (d) the individual's e-mail address, where available;
- (e) the individual's constituency association of record;
- (f) the individual's status as a delegate or an alternate delegate, as the case may be;
- (g) the individual's ranking as an alternate delegate, if the individual is an alternate delegate;
- (h) the constituency association or qualifying association by which the individual was selected as a delegate or alternate delegate, or if the individual is an ex officio delegate, as the case may be;
- (i) whether the individual has paid the prescribed registration fees; and
- (j) whether the individual has obtained credentials for the Convention.

15. Leadership candidates shall be provided by the Provincial Director of the Party, as soon as practical after the close of the time fixed for the promotion of alternate delegates to the status of delegates, with a copy of the final list of voters to be used during balloting at the Convention.

16. The lists to be provided to leadership candidates in accordance with Rules 8 to 14 shall be provided

(a) in an electronic format,

(b) on paper, or

(c) in each of the formats set out in clauses (a) and (b),

as deemed appropriate, in each case, by the subcommittee of the Committee known as the Registration Committee.
